Why are we doing this?

- Shed light on heat stress and other climate change impacts affecting RMG sector and its workforce
- Co-develop training module in a holistic manner with relevant stakeholders to capacitate garment workers in an interactive manner which resonates with their lived realities
- Be a catalyst for initiating social dialogue and policy integration to attain just transition through harnessing tripartite approach

Activities for 2024 - 2026



Co-design the capacity-building training module by incorporating the viewpoints of relevant stakeholders and conducting 1 pilot training (2024-2025)



Capacitate the garment workers in urban and peri-urban areas through conducting 7 trainings with at least 320 workers (2025-2026)



Mutual learning and knowledge exchange visits in Vietnam and Cambodia (2025-2026)



Develop a Training of Trainers (ToT) Module (2026)



Initiate social dialogue with government bodies through a tripartite approach in garment sector (2025-2026)
