Project Summary

The International Centre for Climate Change and Development (ICCCAD), Independent University Bangladesh (IUB), is looking for an enthusiastic and proactive individual to join the organization as a **Research Officer** for the <u>Generating Ambition for Locally Led Adaptation (LLA) project</u> collaboratively undertaken by the International Institute for Environment and Development (IIED) and partner organizations. This initiative is being funded by the Government of the Netherlands.

The project aims to support the implementation of the <u>LLA</u> long-term strategy by building institutional capabilities, fostering partnerships, and enhancing accountability to address climate, nature, and inequality challenges.

Expected Roles and Responsibilities

- Research: Develop research proposals aligned with the eighth principles of LLA with extensive engagement in ethnographic research activities, including frequent field activity, data collection and analysis, and evidence generation to promote partnership and advocacy through successful knowledge dissemination.
- **Communication:** Maintain regular communication with relevant stakeholders for the research purpose.
- **Risk Management:** Support the project team in assessing, flagging, documenting, and communicating existing and potential risks related to the project, and developing risk mitigation strategies.
- **Reporting:** Ensure the project deliverables are met on time, and each of the deliverables is properly documented and reported.
- Quality Assurance: Ensure and maintain the quality of the project deliverables.
- **Publication and Evidence Generation:** Ensure the regular publication of the knowledge that is generated throughout the research activities.
- **Others:** Any other project-related activities appointed by the Senior Research Officer and the Project Manager.





Eligibility

- A minimum of a Master's degree or equivalent in a relevant field:
 Climate Change and Development/Disaster Management/Environmental
 Management/Anthropology/Social Sciences/Development Studies with sound
 academic records.
- Previous experience in ethnographic research, preferably with one to two years' work experience.
- A minimum of one peer-reviewed publication in a reputed journal as first or second author.
- Sound knowledge of Locally Led Adaptation (LLA) and community development.
- Strong analytical skills to gather, analyse, and interpret data effectively.
 Previous experience working with qualitative and quantitative data is essential.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, both in English and Bengali.
- Proficiency in organizing and coordinating communication-related tasks.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a diverse team environment.
- Demonstrate organizational skills, including the ability to multitask and prioritize workload effectively.
